Dear Paredes Parents and Students,

Welcome back to Paredes Middle School! We are excited to begin the 2025–2026 school year and are looking forward to a positive, productive, and engaging school experience for your child. Below, you'll find important information about arrival, dismissal, meals, hallway transitions, and school policies to ensure a smooth start



Arrival Procedures

- Breakfast in the classroom begins at 8:00.
- The cafeteria doors open at 7:30
- Parent drop off in the morning is on the side of the school closest to Mary Moore Searight Drive
- Students should enter through the front gate right next to the office
- Staff will be present to guide students and help them locate their classrooms.
- Please refer to the **school map** (attached/provided at orientation) to familiarize yourself with classroom and hallway locations.

n Dismissal Procedures

- Dismissal begins at 3:50
- Bus riders, walkers, and car riders will be dismissed in a staggered fashion to avoid congestion.
- Parents picking up students by car must use the loop by the cafeteria, the 2nd turn off of Mary Moore Searight.

™ Breakfast and Lunch

- All students receive free breakfast and lunch daily—no need to bring lunch unless preferred.
- We have Breakfast in the Classroom or BIC starting at 8:00 a.m.
- Lunch times are scheduled by grade level. Students will be guided to their assigned lunch period.
- Lunch menus are available on the school website and through the School Cafe.

Hallway Transitions & Passing Periods

- Students have 4 minutes between classes.
- We encourage students to walk on the right side of the hallway and follow all directional
- Staff members will be present during passing periods to assist and supervise.
 - Personal Device Policy (Cell Phones, Tablets, etc.)

While students **may bring** personal devices to school, the use of these devices is **strictly prohibited** during the school day. This includes phones, smartwatches, laptops, earbuds, kindels and tablets.

Violations of this policy will result in the following consequences:

- 1. **First Offense:** Device taken to the office; students may pick it up at the end of the school day.
- 2. **Second Offense:** Device taken to the office; a parent/guardian must come to school to retrieve it.
- 3. **Third Offense and Beyond:** Device held for **48 hours**; parent/guardian must pick up. Additional disciplinary action may be taken.

Please talk with your child about the importance of staying focused and unplugged during the school day.
